“A” Scores in Quality and Service Earn iLevel by Weyerhaeuser a David Weekley Homes’ Prestigious “Partners of Choice” Award

FEDERAL WAY, Wash., July 30, 2010 – Results are in from the nation’s second largest for-profit privately held U.S. homebuilder, David Weekley Homes, in its annual National Trading Partners Survey. David Weekley Home’s Partners of Choice program is unique in providing a measurement tool and constructive feedback to suppliers on their performance directly from a homebuilder customer. The awards are based on the David Weekley Homes National Trading Partners Survey, a running quarterly review of suppliers provided by about 600 team members from all levels within the company. Suppliers are rated on a 1-10 scale for quality and service. The scores for each supplier are averaged and ranked with all other participants. Rankings are assigned in 20% increments from A to F, with the top 20% rated as “A.” Receiving an “A” for both quality and service in the same year is rare, with the “A,A” Partners of Choice Award being the highest ranking any trading partner can receive.

“If we are doing our jobs properly, we are sourcing products from the top two or three leaders in each industry. The difference between a good and a great supplier can often come down to how well they can manage the supply chain to deliver quality products, at competitive prices, on a timely basis,” says Bill Justus, Vice President of Supply Chain Services for David Weekley

Homes. “The National Trading Partner Survey is a practical way of evaluating suppliers’ performance. It is clear that iLevel understands and delivers and has become world-class.”
